How To Get There

Starhotels Savoia Excelsior Palace is in the city centre of Trieste, walking distance to Piazza Unità d'Italia, in front of Stazione Marittima-Palazzo dei Congressi

By car

From North Motorway A23 Udine-Tarvisio to A4 Venezia-Trieste; from South Motorway A4 Venezia-Trieste: toll-gate Trieste-Lisert, exit “Sistiana” (SS 14 “Costiera”). Distance : 26 Km.

By train

From the Central Railway Station 900 m; by walking 15 minutes; by bus line n.8 (exit on the left) and n.30 (Main exit, Piazza Libertà), stop Stazione Marittima

Ronchi dei Legionari International Airport

It is 35 Km far away. Bus service (line 51; www.aprgorizia.it) connects the Airport to the Terminal bus Station in Piazza Libertà, near Central Railway Station

Parking

Free paying: Stazione Marittima area, in front of Savoia Excelsior Palace; Silos near Central Railway Station
